Instructions

- This is an individual activity. You must work alone.
- You will be given a topic and you will have the entire period to create a 1-2 page publication on that topic.
- Use a platform that can create A4 pdf pages such as Google Docs, Word, or Publisher. Do not use Google Slides or Google Sites.

Requirements

Inverted Format

• The article should use the inverted format.

Images

- Each page must include at least one and no more than two images per page.
- Images cannot be more than 25% of the width or height of the page.
- Text must be wrapped around images and must have about a 0.01" spacing between image.
- Images must be flush with the text margins. They should not 'stick out'.

Headings

- Headings are used to identify main sections of the publication if it is more than one page.
- Your publication must include a title.
- Your name and date should appear under the title in normal sized font.

Font

• You must use a standard font between 10pt-12pt.

Organization

- All space on each page must be entirely used.
- You may use an advertisement, but this is not required.

Deliverable

• Publication should be submitted in pdf format.

- Inverted format is very clearly used
